Dr. Bhama specializes in facial cosmetic and reconstructive surgery at Providence Medical Group in Everett, Washington.

Dr. Bhama has special expertise in performing facial surgery to manage facial paralysis and other facial nerve disorders, rhinoplasty (nose-reshaping surgery), complex revision rhinoplasty, management of skin cancer (Mohs reconstruction and skin cancer treatment), melanoma treatment, brow lifts, forehead lifts, otoplasty (ear pinning), scar revision, dermabrasion, and blepharoplasty (eyelid lifting).

He offers a number of non-surgical treatments, as well — both cosmetic and medical — including treatments for sinusitis, nasal obstruction, and facial paralysis; BOTOX®; dermal fillers; “mini facelifts”; fat-transfer injections; and referrals to other specialists, such as physical therapists for patients with facial paralysis. Using local anesthesia, he performs these minimally invasive outpatient procedures in the practice’s state-of-the-art procedure rooms.

Dr. Bhama also helps train the next generation of facial plastic and reconstructive surgeons. He is one of the few teaching surgical faculty for the Virginia Mason Franciscan Health ACPSE accredited fellowship in facial plastic and reconstructive surgery through the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery.
